A WPS Profile is a specialisation of the WPS interface, e.q. making optional operations or parameters mandatory (or removing them 2. A WPS Application Profile is (in the WPS1.0 form) a standardised ProcessDescription which may be found through a registry using its assigned URN. 3. A ProcessDescription is (again, in the WPS1.0 form) a description of a process and its inputs/outputs. It may also indicate that it implements a particular WPS Application Profile.
