How to get to venue

Friends' Meeting House is centrally located only a couple of minutes' walk away from Manchester Town Hall and directly opposite the Central Library.

GETTING HERE BY TRAM

Our nearest stop is St. Peter's Square, which is a 30 second walk away from our front door.

GETTING HERE BY TRAIN

We are within walking distance of all the city centre rail stations, approx times on foot:

Manchester Piccadilly – 20 min

Manchester Victoria – 15 min

Manchester Oxford Rd – 10 min

Transport

Useful App – City Mapper



Citymapper allows you to have an overview of all the transport modes in Manchester as well as showing the closest tram or train stop to your location. If you have a smart phone its worth downloading and is very easy to use. It also has access to transport maps.

Arriving at Manchester International Airport

Manchester Airport is 11km from the city centre.

Trains from airport- run to the centre of Manchester every 15 minutes during the day and 30 mins in the evening. The cost is about £4.00 (varies with time of day) and the journey time is approximately 15 – 20 minutes. Purchase your ticket at the transport interchange BEFORE travel (takes cash or card).

Trams – (the better option is to take the train) – Trams run from Manchester airport every 12 minutes at all times except outside the hours of 9:00am - 5:30pm on Sundays and public holidays when they run every 15 minutes. The journey time from airport to the city centre is one hour (15 stops). Purchase a ticket BEFORE travel.

Taxis- from the airport to the city centre cost approx £25.00 and takes 20-30 minutes.

Arriving at Liverpool Airport

Liverpool Airport is accessible from Manchester and buses to Manchester city centre take an hour. <https://www.liverpoolairport.com/transport/bus>

It is also possible to take a train but this first requires a bus to Liverpool rail station. www.thetrainline.com/train-times/john-lenon-airport-to-manchester-piccadilly

Arriving by Train

Manchester Piccadilly – This is the main train station in Manchester with London trains arriving and departing here every 30 minutes. From here you can take the tram or free shuttle bus to all parts of the city centre. Alternatively (if it's not raining) you are within walking distance to most accommodation and attractions in the city.

Manchester Oxford Road and Manchester Victoria are other alternative train stations that you may arrive or depart from which again are all within the city centre.

City Centre

The city centre is easily accessible on foot, taking no longer than 10 – 15mins to cross the city.

Metrolink - Alternatively, the Metrolink tram service operates up to every 6 minutes during the day, stopping at various points in the city. You must buy a ticket BEFORE boarding. www.metrolink.co.uk

Metroshuttle - is a free city centre bus service, which crosses the centre. The buses are numbered and go on three routes around the city centre. All three of these routes start and end at Manchester Piccadilly Station. <https://tfgm.com/public-transport/bus/free-bus>
